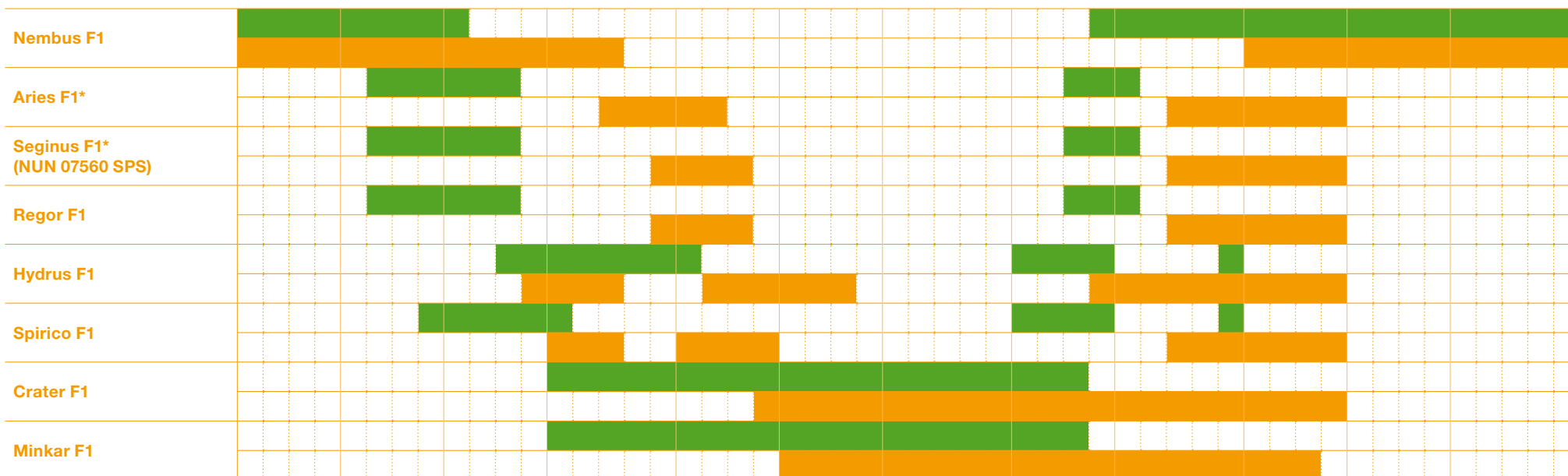

NEMBUS F1



For the cold season

- For glasshouse growing and first outdoor sowings
- Very fast yielding
- Very high growth rate
- Mid-green leaf
- Leaf blisters easily
- HR Pe 1-19, HR Sv

ARIES F1*



Strong leaves and savoy

- Thick leaf
- Dark leaf color
- Medium-sized, round leaves
- Medium fast growing
- Early spring and late autumn
- HR Pe 1-19

SEGINUS F1*

(NUN 07560 SPS)



Fast spinach for May and October harvest

- Round, dark leaves
- Smooth, medium-sized leaves
- Good yield due to thick leaves
- Good growth rate
- HR Pe 1-19

REGOR F1



Smooth baby leaf for May and October harvest

- Very upright, easy to harvest
- Oval, fleshy leaves
- Mid-green leaf
- Classic baby leaf variety
- Large harvesting window
- HR Pe 1-19, HR Sv

HYDRUS F1



Semi-Savoy spinach for early summer and autumn

- Slow development
- Very upright growth
- High yield
- Large harvesting window
- Round, thick, and stable leaves
- HR Pe 1-18, HR Sv

SPIRICO F1



Multipurpose variety for sowing until April and in August

- Good spinach for harvest in May and September/October
- Also usable as a baby and teen leaf with smaller harvesting window
- Very good growth rate combined with slow development rate
- Fast juvenile development = quick ground covering
- Leaves very pliable – do not crack
- Also as winter spinach with good frost hardiness
- HR Pe 1-19, HR Sv

CRATER F1



Baby leaf for May to September

- Slow development
- Combined with good growth rate
- Large harvesting window
- Round, stable leaves
- Semi-savoy
- Upright growth
- Even petiole length
- Tolerates heat
- HR Pe 1-19

MINKAR F1



Baby and teen leaf spinach for the warm season

- Upright growth
- Oval leaves, slightly pointed
- Good growth rate for summer variety
- Dark green, a bit savoy
- Late bolting
- HR Pe 1-19, HR Sv
